Over this term, the Digital Leaders want to remind you how to be an upstander online. Here are some of their top tips:

- ✓ Always report negativity online to a trusted adult
- ✓ Diffuse the negativity of online bullies with positive messages and images
- ✓ Save the evidence (take a screenshot)
- ✓ Offer people being bullied online your friendship, by letting them know you're there if they want to talk

To see if you know your upstanders from your bystanders, the Digital Leaders are challenging Key Stage 2 to a "Create a comic" competition!

The theme of your comic should be: "How to be a DPA Digital Upstander".

To enter, you may either use a paper template provided by your Digital Leader, or create a digital comic use this free website – you **do not** need to create an account.

The winner will receive 10,000 house points, and their comic will be published on the DPA website. Second prize will be 5000 house points.
