



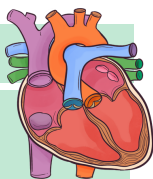
Continuing to develop writing:

- Use organisational devices such as headings, bullet points and topic sentences when it is appropriate.
- Use the subjunctive form in formal language to make a command or a request more formal.

- Considering significance and meaning of artwork

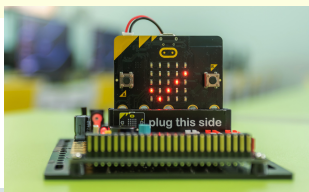
Bees, Beetles and Butterflies

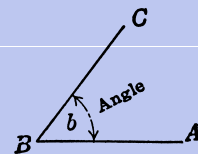

History

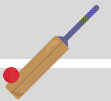
Maafa

- Learn abstract terms: rebellion, discrimination, colonisation, diaspora and emancipation
- Learn about Africa as the 'cradle of humankind', studying a timeline of African history
- In depth study of Kingdom of Benin - location, trade links, hierarchical system, Benin's society - including roles, status, clothing, traditions, trade partners and important events.
- Learn about the significance of the discovery of the New World on African history and study Britain's role in the development and growth of the slave trade over time.
- Learn that the triangular slave trade created the African diaspora.
- Study a wide range of historical evidence to evaluate the human impact of the slave trade, including artefacts, diagrams and sources written by eye witnesses
- Learn about life in enslavement, thinking critically and weighing evidence about the contrasting representations of life in enslavement
- Learn the meaning of terms: resistance, revolt and refusal and how rebellion played a vital role in the abolition of slavery and the causes and consequences of abolition
- Long and short term consequences of colonisation in the 19th and 20th centuries, immigration and the Race Relations Act 1965.
